

# THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST

*as revealed to the Apostle John* • Lesson #91 - April 26th., 2026

**Moderator:** Let's start by reading Revelation 14:12-13:

**Revelation 14:12-13** "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them."

## • #1 THE PATIENCE OF THE TRIBULATION SAINTS (Rev. 14:12)

**Moderator:** Now John turns his attention to the Tribulation Saints...

**Revelation 14:12** "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus."

**Moderator:** Patience here also means "perseverance". For us, this means we must become Overcomers as we endure the trials and temptations of the Devil. For these saints in Tribulation, they will be burdened much more by all the terrible things Satan will do to them personally! We have the scripture to show us how bad this will be. God's word says it, and so it will be.

**Revelation 14:13** "And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them."

## • THE TRIBULATION SAINTS & ALL THE SAVED WILL OVERCOME SATAN

**Moderator:** This is Jesus speaking here in Revelation Chapter 3. We have not covered this chapter yet but there are many references to being "overcomers"...

**Revelation 3:5** "He that OVERCOMETH, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels."

**Revelation 3:8-12** "I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name. Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee. Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth. Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown. Him that OVERCOMETH will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name."

**Revelation 3:20-22** "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. To him that OVERCOMETH will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches."

**Revelation 2:7** "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that OVERCOMETH will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God."

**Revelation 2:11** “He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that OVERCOMETH shall not be hurt of the second death.”

**Revelation 2:17** “He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that OVERCOMETH will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.”

**Revelation 2:26** “And he that OVERCOMETH, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:”

- **WE MUST CONTINUE TO SERVE CHRIST FAITHFULLY TO OVERCOME**

**I John 5:1-5** “Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous. For whatsoever is born of God OVERCOMETH the world: and this is the victory that OVERCOMETH the world, even our faith. Who is he that OVERCOMETH the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?”

**John 16:33** “These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have OVERCOME the world.”

- **WE MUST BE VICTORIOUS IN THIS LIFE BECAUSE WE ARE IN CHRIST**

**Moderator:** Worrying about things we can't control leads to depression and doubt. Let's remember that nothing can happen unless God ordains it. We have the promises of God revealed to us in the one book we can totally rely on...the Bible. This book speaks of our overcoming many things, Let's just believe what it says and keep working for the Lord!

**Matthew 6:34** “Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.”

**Hebrews 3:14** “For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;”

**Moderator:** We should use our faith to not show the world our worries. Our testimony should be that people ask us “How can you be so happy when all this is happening to you?” Confidence in the Lord is vital to our witnessing.

**Romans 8:35-39** “Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

**I Corinthians 15:57-58** “But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.”

- **#2 BLESSED ARE THE DEAD WHICH DIE IN THE LORD** (Rev. 14:13)

**Revelation 14:13** “And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.”

**Romans 12:19** “Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.”
